

## Recessed Board Meeting Minutes March 4, 2020

Resolution of the Board of Directors of the Pearl River County Utility Authority Authorizing the Employment of Butler Snow, LLP and Government Consultants, Inc, in Connection with the Issuance of Utility System Revenue Bonds of the Authority to Raise Money for the Purpose of the Acquisition, Construction, Improvement and Equipping of and Administration Building for the Operations of the Authority and its Utility System, or any Part thereof and Paying the Costs of Issuance of Such Bonds, (Together the "Project): Motion to approve by Ernie Lovell, seconded by Bill Burns. Resolution of the Board of Directors of the Pearl River County Utility Authority Declaring the Intention of the Authority to Issue Utility System Revenue Bonds of the Authority in the Maximum Principal Amount of Not to Exceed Eight Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$850,000) to Raise Money for the Purpose of the Acquisition, Construction, Improvement and Equipping of an Administration Building for the Operations of the Authority and its Issuance of Such Bonds, and for Related Purposes. Motion to approve by Billy Spiers, seconded by Bill Burns. A roll call resulted in the following votes:
